Prizes:

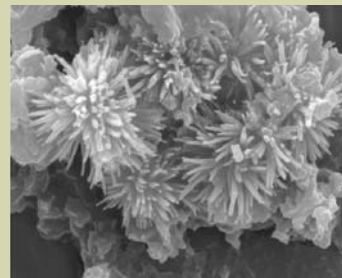
- Winners are selected by a popular vote of DCASS attendees
